


Description












February 4- World Cancer Day

Description

As part of WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (June 5) celebrations, Department of Civil Engineering Sree Buddha College of Engineering, Pattoor, Alappuzha in association with CASTELLOS and IEI Kollam chapter conducted an online design competition *Navaritih'21* on 5th and an expert talk on *Ecosystem Restoration* on 6th of June 2021 respectively. The event aimed at creating awareness on importance of protection of the environment. Navaritih'21-the design competition was a single event encompassing two rounds to set students creativity ablaze. About 15 teams from different colleges under KTU across Kerala consisting of two members each had participated in this event.

On 5th June 2021, inauguration of the event was conducted in a virtual platform gmeet at 9.00 am. The honorable HoD of Civil Department, SBCE, Dr. Gouri Antherjanam, inaugurated the tech event Navaritih'21. Dr. R. Gopakumar, Professor, Civil Engineering department felicitated the event and explained about the theme of World Environment Day 2021-'Ecosystem Restoration'.

First round of the competition was *Reviving the abode'-Sustainable Habitat Design*, in which the students were given a site layout and were asked to prepare layout of a residential area in AutoCAD to accommodate 250 inhabitants in the given site. Students were urged to implement sustainable concepts in their layout and to explain the same through an audio. From this, 5 teams were selected for Round 2. Subsequently, on 6th June 2021 second round of competition "*Our Solutions are in Nature*" which is a presentation round commenced from 9.00 am. In this round, four problem statements related to the environment day 2021 theme were given to the selected team members. The themes given were: i. Restoration of wetland ecosystem from micro plastics in view of Vembanad lake, ii. Minimising the impact


of quarrying mountain ecosystem in view of Kavalapara, iii. Restoring ground water ecosystem of Plachimada iv. Restoring water quality of polluted rivers. The participants presented the selected themes before the judges without exceeding 10 minutes. Queries were also asked to the contestants by judging panel consists of Dr. R. Gopakumar and Assistant professor Ms. Regi P. Mohan. Winners were selected based on their overall performance in Round 1 and Round 2. At the end of day 2 at 3.00 pm Closing Ceremony was conducted.

In the closing ceremony conducted at 3.00pm on 6th June 2021, Dr. R. Gopakumar, Professor, Department of Civil Engineering delivered an expert talk on *Ecosystem Restoration* focusing on the importance of maintaining a sustainable environment through real life problems from Kerala context. He presented a case study regarding the environmental changes happened at Attappady, Kerala after the implementation of Ecosystem Restoration. Dr. Gouri Antherjanam, HoD, Professor, Department of Civil Engineering, gave a Concluding Remarks and declared the winners of the online design competition Navaritih'21. Mr. Devanarayanan R, Secretary of Castellos, delivered a vote of thanks to all. The event coordinator Sam Koshy appreciated the participants for their zeal and vitality and mentioned the dedication of the entire team behind the success of the event.

The winners of the competition were Anjima U. and Felix Thomas (Government College of Engineering, Thrissur) and Ajay Saji and Ann Mariya Deve M. D. (Amal Jyothi College of Engineering, Kanjirappally). Winners were awarded with a cash prize of ₹2000 and 1500 for first and second place respectively. They also shared their experience about the tech event.

This event brought together students from different colleges under KTU to brainstorm on bridging the gap between man and ecosystem. It also served as a platform for the aspiring engineers to bring out their skills in the Civil Engineering field.


❖ SRAAVANOLSAVAM- E Onam, Nammude Onam
