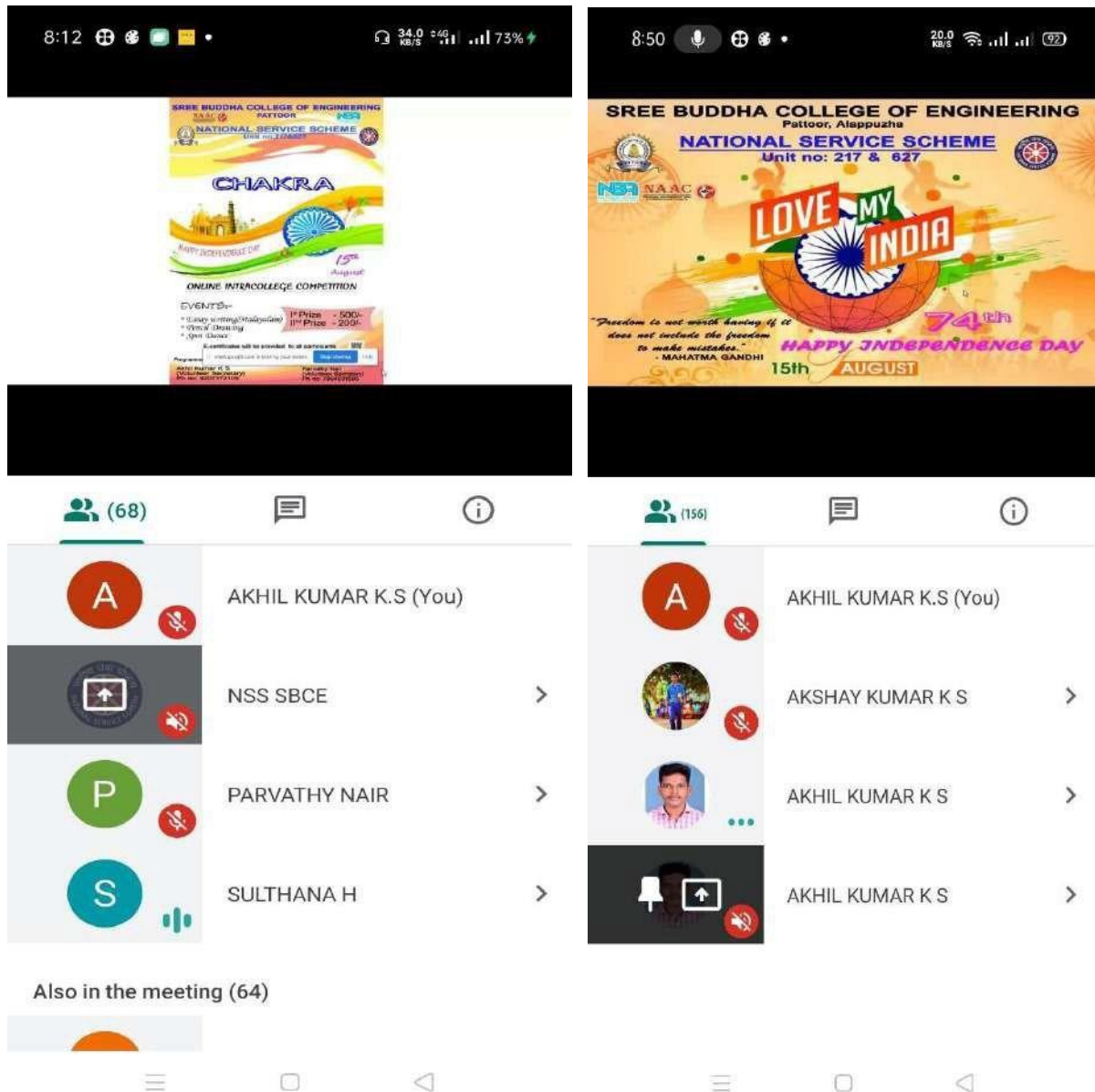
## June 5<sup>th</sup> –Environmental Day

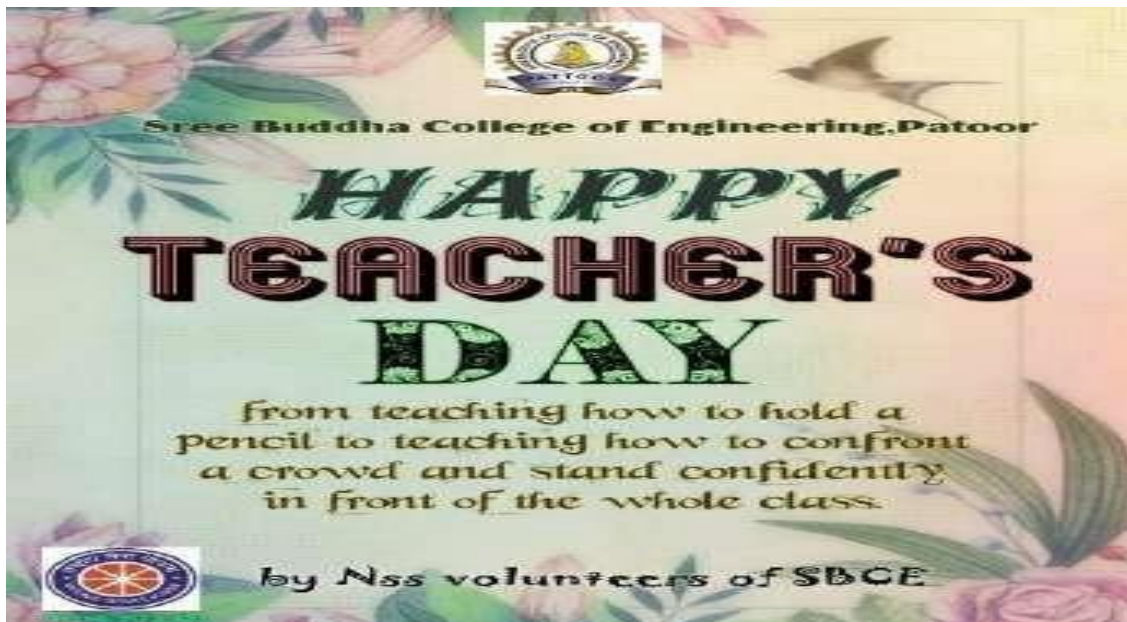
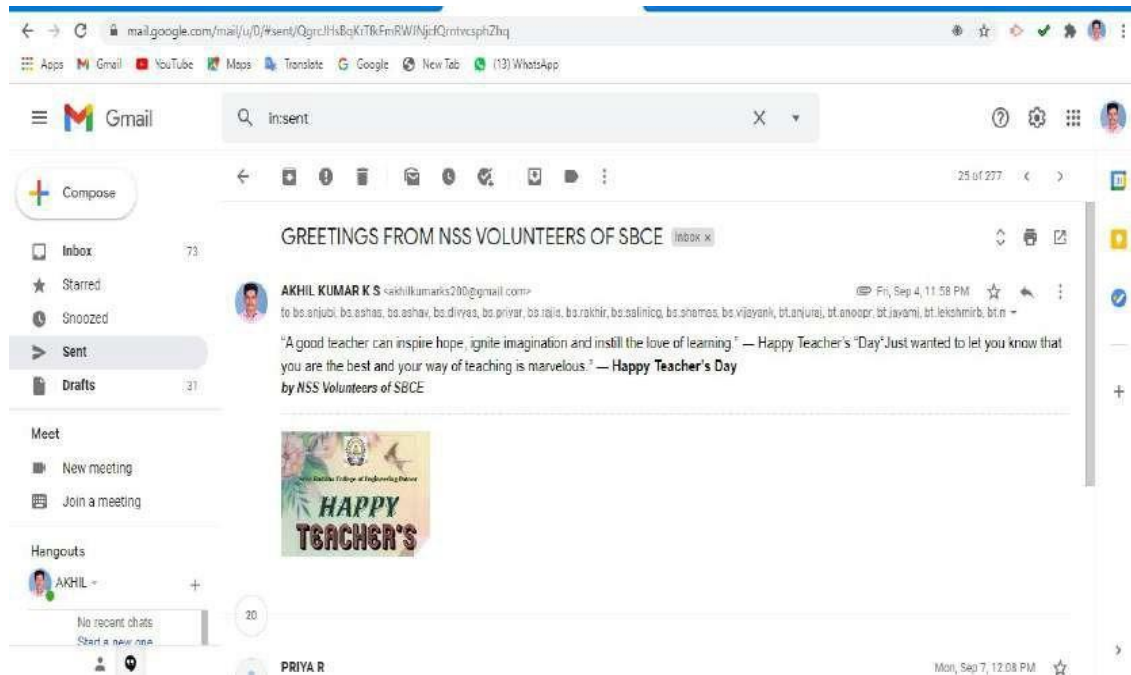
## August 15<sup>th</sup>–Independence Day

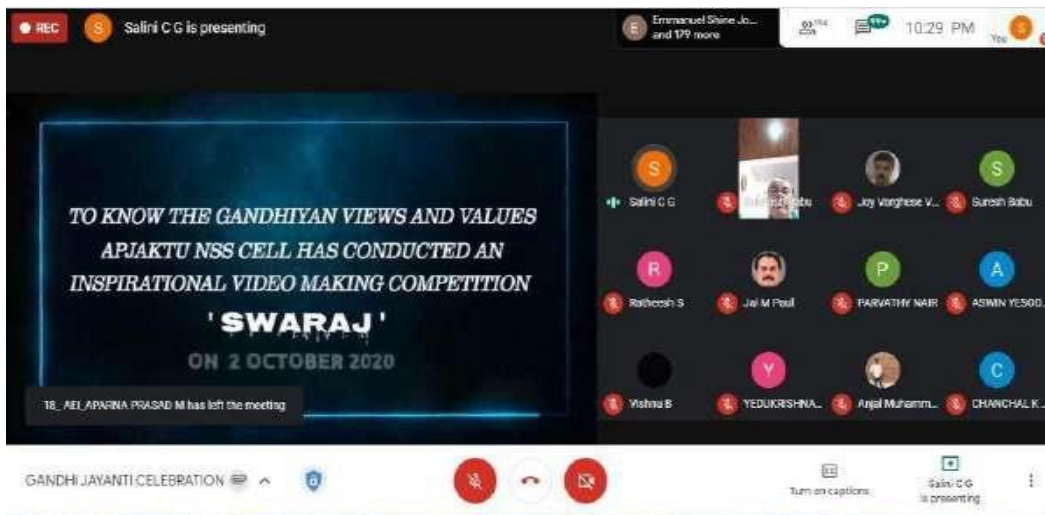
## September 5<sup>th</sup>–Teacher’s Day

# October 2<sup>nd</sup>–Gandhi Jayanthi



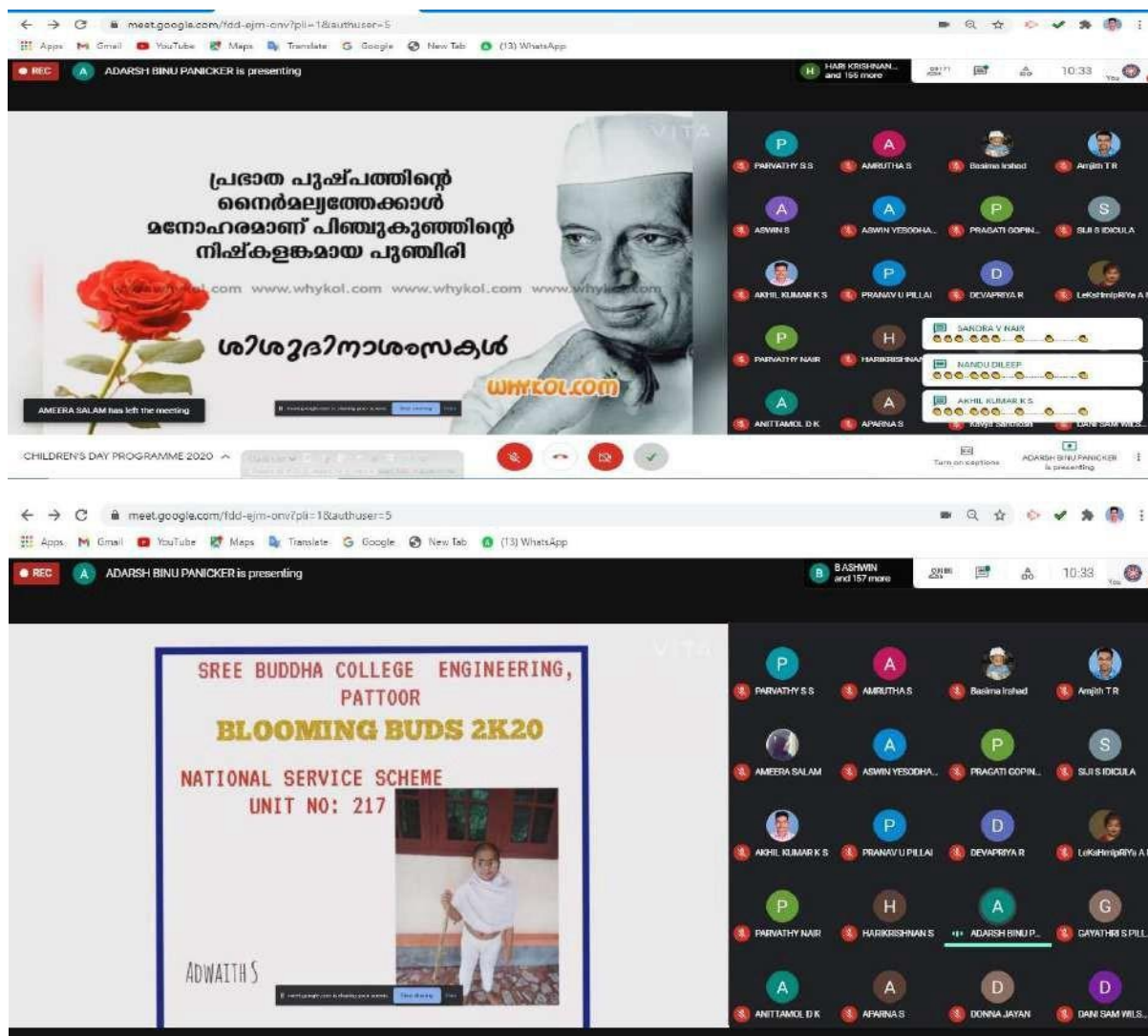
