1.	The Chairman welcomed all the BoS members and briefed them on the agenda of the BoS meeting.		
2.	The Chairman presented the curriculum and syllabus for the B.Tech program.		
3.	The Chairman informed the board that the department is following the KTU 2024 curriculum and syllabus for the B.Tech program in Electrical and Electronics Engineering and KTU 2022 curriculum and syllabus for the M.Tech in Electrical Machines for the academic year 2024-25.	Academic Council	
4.	BoS member Dr. D. Elangovan highlighted that the new syllabus from KTU is well-structured and similar to the curriculum followed by prestigious institutions, setting a high academic standard for the department.	BoS Chairman	
5.	Dr. D. Elangovan proposed and agreed that the 8th semester should primarily focus on enabling students to undertake major projects in industry or research labs. This approach aims to provide students with hands-on experience and real-world problem-solving opportunities, which are crucial for their professional development.	BoS Chairman	
6.	BoS member Dr. Asha Rani M.A. accepted the opinions of Dr. D. Elangovan and suggested the inclusion of measurement and instrumentation (only basic measuring instruments) within the syllabus of Basic Electrical and Electronics Engineering, stating that it will enhance students' practical skills, especially for those in Group C. 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7.	BoS member Dr. Jaison Mathew accepted the opinions of Dr. D. Elangovan and Dr. Asha Rani
	M.A. regarding the KTU 2024 syllabus and
	approved the decision to follow it for the
	department. Dr. Jaison Mathew also suggested and
	recommended that seminars and workshops be
	conducted by industry experts to provide students
	with practical exposure and insights into current
	industry practices. In addition, he suggested including more core courses in the curriculum.

8. BoS member Mr. George Shelly L suggested that students need to study and understand the requirements of the industry. He emphasized that students should be well-prepared to understand their roles in an industrial environment, ensuring that they are equipped to meet the challenges and demands of their future careers.

10. BoS member Dr. D. Elangovan highlighted that PG students should focus more on research and publish their work in reputed journals and conferences. Different papers based on control systems were merged into a single control systems paper, which includes all topics relevant to the core stream, setting a high academic standard for the department.
