The following guidelines are written in the format required for submission of abstracts not exceeding 1 page to the International Conference on “Smart & Green Materials for Biotechnology, Biochemical and Mechanical Applications” (IC-SGMat). The authors can download the template named ‘Template-abstract.docx’ for abstract preparation. The template is a MS-Word Document file which can be directly used for typing the abstract. Place the cursor and start typing your content directly. After typing your content, delete the words already typed in the template. The abstract should briefly state the purpose/motivation and objectives of the research, the hypothesis that was tested or a description of the problem being analyzed or evaluated, data collection and methods of analysis used, possible findings/outcome of the study, with specific results summarized in the end. ‘Times New Roman’ should be used when formatting the text. Single line spacing should be used. Author names are separated by commas and marked with superscript when necessary to distinguish authors from different affiliations. Authors’ affiliations (style: 12 pt, italic, centered) are to be written in separate rows when there are more than one. Abstract body text (12pt) must be fully justified. The first line of the paragraph must be indented. The final ‘.docx’ file must be converted to PDF format by using any file conversion software and the ‘.pdf’ file must be submitted in **preregistration form**.

The abstract has to be submitted on or before **27/02/2025**. The abstract will be screened and the ‘corresponding author’, whose email address is given in the title, will be informed about the acceptance of abstract on or before **28/02/2025**.
